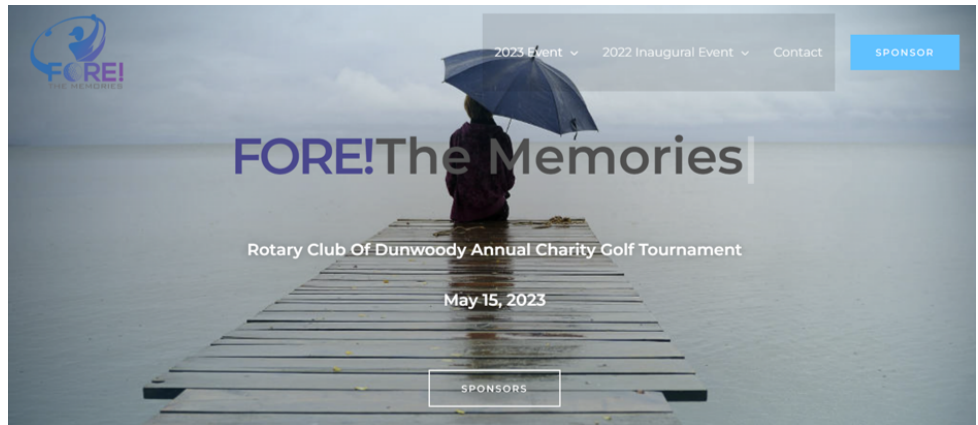
Whiskey Raffle #3: Two Weeks, 52 Tickets Remaining
